Collect of the Day

Almighty Father, whose Son was revealed in majesty before he suffered death upon the cross: give us grace to perceive his glory, that we may be strengthened to suffer with him and be changed into his likeness, from glory to glory; who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

First Reading 2 Kings 2:1-12

The vision of Elijah being taken into heaven confirms his greatness, and also encourages Elisha in his calling, giving him confidence to begin his own powerful ministry as a prophet.

Second Reading 2 Corinthians 4:3-6

The glory of God is revealed in Jesus Christ, but this is only clear to those who have believed the Gospel.

Gospel Mark 9:2-9

Jesus' true nature and identity is revealed to a select group of disciples who are able – albeit only just – to recognise him for who he is.
